Is my child entitled to a free place?

You can claim a free place for your child if you receive one or more of the following:

- Income Support
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- O Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income below £16,190 (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs) Families in receipt of Working Tax Credit must submit a copy of their current TC602 form received from HM Inspector of Taxes dated within the last 12 months.
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- If the 2 year old has a current statement of SEN or an Education Health and Care Plan
- If the 2 year old attracts Disability Living Allowance (families must submit copy of their current award letter received from Department of Work & Pensions dated within the last 12 months).
- If the 2 year old is looked after by their Local Authority.
- If the 2 year old has left care through special guardianship or an adoption or residence order.

Children are also eligible if they or their family are receiving support or services from Children's Targeted Service social work teams.

How do I know my child will be well looked after?



The free places will only be available from childcare providers who are proven to offer the highest possible standards of care for two year olds.

How do I dpply?

- Complete the form on the next page. Please note, any applications that do not have the parent's date of birth and national insurance number cannot be processed. Please check that these details have been entered correctly on to the form.
- If you are eligible we will send you a voucher to give to your chosen childcare provider we will also send a list of approved childcare providers where your child can take their place.
- Contact your preferred childcare provider and arrange to visit Check if they have a place at the times you need. You may find it useful to contact Warrington Families Information Service (FIS) or visit www.warringtonchildren.org for advice on what questions to ask childcare providers.
- Give your voucher to your chosen provider and provide a copy of your child's birth certificate.
- Once you have secured a place, your childcare provider will ask you to complete a registration form and contract.

What else do I need to know?

Completing the application form does not guarantee a funded nursery place. We cannot guarantee that places will be available at your first choice provider and all places are subject to availability.
