

## Key Stage 1 Homework Guide

- The information below explains what homework your child will be required to complete each week.
- Your child will have a homework book. This is for comprehension homework and spellings.
- Your child will also have a reading diary for you to record reading in.
- If your child struggles with any of the work, either speak to your child's teacher in person or write a note in his/her book.
- If there is a reason why the homework couldn't be completed, just write a note in your child's book.
- Year 1 children will receive a login for Spelling Shed and Numbots.

<b>Comprehension/ Reading</b>	Your child will receive two books a week that they need to read to you. One book will have questions linked to your child's reading book or a simple writing task based on their book and this will be given out the day your child reads with their teacher (once a week) and it will need to be completed by the same day the following week. The answers need to be recorded in their homework book. Your child will also receive another book to read but there will be no questions linked to this book. The children's reading diaries will be checked weekly. We encourage reading 5 times a week. Please record your child's reading in their diary.	Your child will receive one reading book a week. Questions linked to your child's guided reading book or a simple writing task based on their book will be given out the day your child reads with their teacher (once a week) and it will need to be completed by the same day the following week. The answers need to be recorded in their homework book. The children's reading diaries will be checked weekly. We encourage reading 5 times a week. Please record your child's reading in their diary.
