



The information below explains what homework your child will be required to complete each week.



Google Classroom

Beginning this week, your child will be completing their homework through **Google Classroom**. Your child will be able to 'turn in' their grammar and arithmetic homework online. The week's spellings will be sent home but will also be uploaded onto your child's classroom. We will be providing further information and videos around how to turn homework in online. If you have any problems accessing Google Classroom, please inform your child's teacher who will be able to provide online support and paper copies if needed.

English

- **Reading** – please aim to read at home **5** times a week. Please sign your child's reading record after each time they have read; children can also write their book information in their reading records. Your child will be encouraged to choose a book from our class library or they are welcome to choose a book or other text (magazine, article, sports event programme etc.) from home. Some children may also be given a recommended text by their teacher to read. Reading can also be quizzes completed on Read Theory
- **Grammar** – your child will be set a Grammar activity to complete on the website SPAG.com (Login details for SPAG.com will be provided in a separate letter). Across the year, this will cover all grammar objectives in the Lower Key Stage Two English Curriculum. This will be set weekly on a Friday. This should be handed in/turned in online by Friday morning.
- **Spellings** – 10 spellings will be given weekly on a Friday. These spellings will reinforce the spelling rule that your child will be working on in class during the week. Your child will be tested on their spellings the following Friday

Maths

- **Arithmetic** - your child will be given 15 to 20 arithmetic style questions to answer at home. They should complete these independently in 15 minutes. Do not spend any more than 20 minutes on these questions, even if they are incomplete. This should be handed in/turned in online by Friday morning.
- **Times Table Rock Stars** – your child will be set a minimum of 10 studio games to complete at home each week. Tables are set automatically depending on your child's individual progress. After these set games, they can access the game as normal and play different games as many times as they wish. Login details will be given in a separate letter for your child.
